Members are entitled to, upon presentation of their current Membership card, admission to the racecourse and Members Reserve at any race meeting conducted by the Club at Royal Randwick, Rosehill Gardens, Warwick Farm and Canterbury Park racecourses.

ABSENTEE MEMBERSHIP WE GIVE YOU FLEXIBILITY WHEN YOU NEED IT

Absentee Membership enables Members, after a payment of a \$80 Absentee Fee, to retain their Membership for the period of their absence. Members may only subscribe to Absentee Membership for a maximum of two consecutive years. At the conclusion of the second year of Absentee Membership, a renewal form will be sent to the Member outlining the full fee due for the following year.

Absentee Members are not entitled to exercise any rights or privileges of full Membership such as voting rights, purchasing daily Members tickets or making reservations in the Members dining areas. In addition, they will not receive a Membership card.

Members wishing to reinstate their Membership will be required to pay the full season's annual fee. If reinstatement is part way through a season (1 January 2020 – 31 December 2020), the full season payment is due less the \$80 Absentee Fee already paid.

WE VALUE & REWARD LOYALTY

TENURE DISCOUNT

The Australian Turf Club values Member loyalty and as such offers a discount on the base annual fee. The discount increases based on years of loyalty with the Club.

Discounts are as follows:

5 years: 5% 10 years: 10% 15 years: 15%

20 years: 20%

30 years: 50%

50 years: 100%

Membership tenure is based on the number of consecutive years a Member has been financial at the start of the season (1 January 2020). If a Membership lapses at any time and the Member chooses to rejoin the Club, the joining date will be reset to the date of rejoining. A Member must serve the full amount of years before receiving the relevant discount (for example, a five year tenure discount will be awarded in the sixth year of Membership).

If a Member qualifies for multiple discounts in addition to tenure, the discount that provides the Member with the greatest saving will be applied. Only one discount will be applied per Membership.

LOYALTY REWARD SEATING

The Members Loyalty Reward Seating program aims to recognise Member loyalty by providing complimentary reserved seating for eligible Members on Saturday racedays at Royal Randwick and Rosehill Gardens.

Members who attend more than ten Saturday racedays (based on specific dates set by the Australian Turf Club throughout the year), are eligble to participate in this program.

Once you reach this milestone, you will be notified and have the option to register online for a seat in the Skyline Reserve at Royal Randwick or Members Only seating at Rosehill Gardens. Register your details on our website and go in the ballot to be allocated a seat at any chosen Saturday raceday.

general information KEEPING IN TOUCH

ANNUAL GUEST CARD

Members may purchase up to five Annual Guest cards, which admits their Guest into the racecourse and Members Reserve for any meeting held at Royal Randwick. Rosehill Gardens. Canterbury Park and Warwick Farm. These cards are fully transferable. Annual Guest card holders are not considered financial Members of the Australian Turf Club and therefore are not entitled to Members benefits. such as purchasing daily Member Guest tickets or making reservations in Members restaurants. Annual Guest card holders are permitted in the Members Only Areas at Royal Randwick and Rosehill Gardens, when accompanied by the Member.

Annual Guest cards may be purchased for \$425 per card (max five per Member).

MERCHANDISE

Merchandise is available for purchase during the 2020 Membership season online or from the head office located in the Administration Building at Royal Randwick.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR PERSONAL DETAILS

If your address or contact details change throughout the course of the Membership season, you are required to notify Membership as soon as possible. These changes may be made by visiting australianturfclub.com.au and clicking on the 'Update Your Details' on the footer of the website, or advise in writing by email or mail. For name changes, please include proof of the change e.g. Marriage Certificate.

MEMBERSHIP RENEWALS

The Membership season runs from 1 January 2020 through to 31 December 2020.

Members who fail to renew Membership within the 2020 season, will result in their Membership being classified as lapsed (unfinancial) and the existing Membership card or any Annual Guest cards will be made inactive. Any lapsed Members wishing to re-join the Club will be required to join the Membership Waitlist and will receive communications pertaining to their entitlements and upcoming election dates.

MEMBERS COMMUNICATIONS

At the time of renewing your Membership, you had the option to opt in or out of Membership communication. Email communication is sent to inform you of upcoming promotions, events, racedays and other information throughout the season. This also includes information pertaining to the AGM and the distribution of the Annual Report and Voting material. RAGEDAY INFORMATION MEMBERS GATES

Entry to all four racecourses is via turnstiles at each entry point. Members and Annual Guest cards admit the patron into both the racecourse and Members Reserve.

GATE OPENING TIMES

The Australian Turf Club website and Members e-newsletter displays the latest gate opening times. Gate times vary depending on each race meeting.

As a general rule, Members gates open 15 minutes prior to General Admission gates. Under no circumstances are Members permitted to enter the racecourse or Members Reserve prior to the gate opening times. Members found inside the racecourse gates prior to the official gate opening times will be asked to exit the racecourse.

ACCESSIBILTIY AREAS IN THE MEMBERS RESERVE

Disability access is available to all levels of the Members Reserve at Rosehill Gardens, Royal Randwick, Canterbury Park and Warwick Farm. Access is via the lift and disability toilets are available on specific levels.

Purchased tickets will NOT be refunded under any circumstances.

PURCHASING TICKETS

There are a number of methods in which Members can purchase Member Reserve Guest tickets:

IN PERSON

Monday to Friday, 10am-4pm at the Administration Office at Royal Randwick or on the raceday from the designated ticket office.

Tickets will not be left for collection on a raceday unless full payment has been received.



Daily Members Reserve Guests tickets admit bearer to the Members Reserve but not into Members Only Areas.

Children 17 years of age and under are admitted FREE into the Members Reserve, provided they are accompanied by a responsible parent or guardian aged adult with a consent letter from their parent. Children entering the Members Reserve must wear a wristband which can be obtained from the designated Raceday Ticket Office.

If aged 14 or over, children must adhere to the adult Members dress regulations.

POLICIES IMPORTANT MEMBERS INFORMATION

EARLY RENEWAL REWARDS

Those who renew 2020 Membership by 31 December 2019 received six complimentary Member Guest ticket vouchers available to redeem for Members Reserve Guest tickets throughout the year. These vouchers may be used on all racedays with the exception of selected major feature racedays (visit the website for more information). To redeem, post your vouchers to Membership at Locked Bag 3, Randwick NSW 2031 and specify the raceday for which you would like to redeem the voucher for, or in person, present the voucher at the Members Gate or Concierge.

The Member does not need to be present for the redemption of vouchers on a raceday. Vouchers will not be replaced if lost or exchanged for cash. Vouchers are accepted on the presentation of the original version only and copies will not be accepted.

MOBILE PHONES

Please be aware, in NSW it is illegal to communicate betting information to any person not at the racecourse. Whilst the use of mobile phones is permitted within the Members Reserve area, Members are asked to consider the comfort of others by not using mobiles within confined areas. Mobile phones are strictly prohibited inside the parade ring.

GLASS IN THE GRANDSTAND AREA

For overall safety of Members and Guests, glass cannot be taken into the Grandstand seating area. Drinks purchased in glass can be transferred into plastic cups at all Grandstand entrances and exits.

SMOKING POLICY

In accordance with NSW State Government regulations, Australian Turf Club racecourses are considered as smoke-free, with the exception of designated smoking areas at each venue. To find these areas, please contact Membership or approach Customer Service Staff on a raceday.

COURTESY BUGGIES

For the convenience and comfort of Members, courtesy buggies operate at all Royal Randwick and Rosehill Gardens Saturday meetings and during carnival periods, to help transport Members and Guests. Preference will be given to those who require assistance. At Royal Randwick, buggies travel from the Infield Car Park via the pedestrian tunnel to the concourse. At Rosehill Gardens, buggies travel from the Might and Power entrance to the Members Reserve Grandstand entrance. Buggies will operate from gate opening time until 30 minutes after the last Sydney race.

CHILDREN'S ENTERTAINMENT

On nominated racedays, children's entertainment will be provided at each of the four venues, please visit australianturfclub.com.au for updates and details.

MEMBERS COACH SERVICE

Reservations can be made via the Australian Turf Club website or by contacting Membership on 02 9663 8419. Bookings for this service close 12 noon each Friday prior to the raceday. A nonrefundable \$10 booking fee applies per person.

MEMBERS ONLY AREAS

The Members Only Area at Rosehill Gardens is located on the Ground Level of the Members Reserve. The Skyline Room on Level 3 of the QEII Grandstand at Royal Randwick is available for the exclusive use of hard card Members.

The following guidelines have been established for these Members Only Areas and will be enforced on a raceday:

Only Full Members in possession of their current Membership card will be admitted to these areas

Guests in possession of an Annual Guest card will be admitted to these areas. Annual Guest card holders must be in the company of a Member at all times

The Members Only areas are only accessible from the official gate opening times

Seats cannot be held for late arrivals or moved

Guests in possession of a Members Guest tickets or Owners ticket will not be permitted

Reciprocal Club Members are not permitted into these areas

Children are not permitted in the Members Only Areas (exception for babies aged 0-1 year old if in a stroller / pram)

The Club reserves the right to alter the configurations of these areas at any time

MEMBERS CONCIERGE

The Members Concierge at Rosehill Gardens is located on the Ground Level, in the Lift Foyer. The Royal Randwick Concierge is positioned in the North Drum on the Ground Level of the Members Reserve in the QEII Grandstand. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

FORGOTTEN CARDS ON RACEDAYS

Should you forget to bring your Membership card on a raceday, you will be required to pay the racecourse admission fee to gain entry (please note prices vary dependent on the raceday). Once paid, you will receive a temporary Members Reserve ticket for the day. The supply of a temporary Members Reserve ticket will cancel your Membership card for that day.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

To ensure the safety and comfort of all Guests visiting our racecourses, a number of conditions of entry are in place. Please visit the website for a full list of conditions.

SUSPENSION OF MEMBERSHIP

Members must adhere to the terms agreed upon at the time of application to Membership. Breach of these terms may result in automatic suspension of Membership. Appropriate behaviour is expected from Members at all times and any deviation from acceptable behaviour will not be tolerated under any circumstances. The Australian Turf Club reserves the right to repossess the Membership card of any Member who is deemed to be in breach of Australian Turf Club rules and regulations, including causing disruption, abusive behaviour. offensive language and the misuse of any Membership products.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Please keep your Membership card safe. Membership cards remain the property of the Australian Turf Club at all times. The Membership card is to be displayed at all times when on course and supplied, along with supporting photo identification upon request to an Australian Turf Club Official. Failure to comply may see the card bearer removed from the Members Reserve and racecourse.

The loss or theft of Membership cards, Annual Guest cards or Car Park passes must be reported to Membership as soon as possible.

If lost, a replacement fee of \$30 applies to each item (Membership card, Annual Guest card or Car Park pass). The fee will be waived if a copy of a stolen property police report can be provided.

MISUSE OF MEMBERSHIP CARD

Membership cards are strictly **NOT TRANSFERABLE**. The lending of a Membership card to a non-Member for use is a serious breach of the Australian Turf Club Rules and will lead to a review by the Board of Directors. Lending Membership cards in order to purchase daily Members Guest tickets is also prohibited and will result in confiscation of the Membership card.

BEHAVIOUR IN THE MEMBERS RESERVE

Members are asked to respect the comfort and enjoyment of patrons within the Members Reserve at all times. Inappropriate or offensive behaviour may result in the offender being removed from the racecourse and their Membership reviewed by the Board of Directors. Members are reminded that they are responsible for the behaviour of their Guests whilst in the Members Reserve, as well as ensuring all Guests are appropriately attired and adhere to the Dress Regulations.

The Australian Turf Club enforces the responsible service of alcohol and not serving patrons under the age of 18 years. The Australian Turf Club reserves the right to remove any intoxicated or disorderly patrons.

The Australian Turf Club has a zero tolerance for illegal substances at its venues.

MEMBER'S GUESTS

Members are responsible for their Guests and Guest behaviour. All Guests must adhere to the same rules that apply to Members, including dress regulations, behaviour, conditions of entry and all other areas covered in the Club Rules.

DRESS REGULATIONS ROYAL RANDWICK & ROSEHILL GARDENS

For any race meeting held at either Royal Randwick or Rosehill Gardens the following dress regulations apply in the Members Reserve areas:

GENTLEMEN

(Including children 14 years and over)

Gentlemen are required to wear tailored pants, dress shoes with socks, a collared shirt and tie and either a suit jacket, sports coat or blazer. During Daylight Saving, jackets are optional within the Members Reserve.

Not acceptable

Any form of the following footwear; joggers, sports shoes, track shoes, runners, sandals, thongs, dilapidated footwear, scuffs, gumboots or slippers

Shoes without socks

Jeans/denim, jodhpurs, shorts or untailored slacks

Torn or ripped clothing

Open neck shirts or shirts with no collar

Parkas, duffle coats, windbreakers, tracksuit tops, denim jackets or anoraks, leather bomber jackets

Tracksuits

Peaked caps, beanies

Pullovers or cardigans (without a jacket), rugby tops and football guernseys

LADIES

(Including children 14 years and over)

Not acceptable

Any form of the following footwear; joggers, sports shoes, track shoes, runners, thongs, dilapidated footwear, scuffs, gumboots or slippers

Jeans/denim, jodhpurs, shorts, untailored pants or playsuits

Torn or ripped clothing

Garments which show midriff or exposed skin (ie. cut-outs)

Leggings worn as pants

Parkas, duffle coats, windbreakers, tracksuit tops, denim jackets or anoraks

ACCESS WORLD-CLASS PARTNER CLUBS

Reciprocal arrangements exist with a number of interstate and international race clubs and sporting venues.

In general, Members are required to pay admission to the racecourse or venue and proceed to the ticket office where a Members Reserve pass will be made available upon presentation of a current Membership Card and Photo Identification.

It is not incumbent upon a reciprocating Club to extend this privilege to anyone accompanying a Member. However, most Clubs also provide the facility to purchase additional passes for Guests. Members should be aware some Clubs impose special conditions on feature race meetings. It is advisable for Members to contact the specific Club or sporting venue in which they wish to visit as to ascertain their privileges and conditions.
